


Johnson County Amateur Radio Club - Alternative Communications Ishikawa Diagram




Type of Entity 16 responses




Damage Assessment

Comments 3 responses

- 1. KB4RHM reports BOTH CAR AND TRUCK INOPERABLE
- 2. K4IVN reports I have learned that even with a generac I still need to purchase some solar back up for my radios. I also think it would be a good idea to establish in every community a central communication point where people could go to that could have us with radios and could get information in and out to others community-wide, county-wide and state-wide. Many people were cut off and had no communication at all wondering how their friends and family were and no way to find out.
- 3. W4TVJ reports the Main JCARC repeater (146.610) functioning and was monitoring traffic. Callalantee JCARC repeater (145.470) out-of-service due to tower/antenna damage. Stone Mtn GMRS repeater not functioning; unknown status Shady Valley GMRS

repeater. Winlink was not functional while the internet was out. Nearby Winlink digipeaters (from 10-70 miles out) not reachable or out of commission. On backup generator power throughout the period (still ongoing).

- 4. KW4DHT reports POWER POLE, TRANSFORMER AND CABLES ON THE GROUND 9+ DAYS
- 5. KC3DCI reports I don't have a landline, only cell and radio. Thanks Coleman
- 6. N4JEM left Damage Status and Time Length responses blank. Assume N/A or 0 days affected, as indicates all assets were unaffected from weather event.
- KQ4SMV reports HF antenna still down, awaiting parts. Standby Generac generator still down, awaiting parts and service. Will abandon landline and DSL (BrightSpeed) in favor of StarLink. Mobile and Handheld Transceiver radios were assets. Intend to establish a valley-wide net.
- 8. KW4DHT reports heavy rain and wind causing numerous large trees down, blocking roads and taking down power and telephone lines. Not repaired after 9 days. Gone to StarLink for internet service.
- 9. Church has FRS (Family Radio Service) radios onsite.
